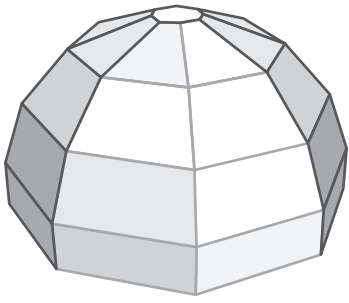
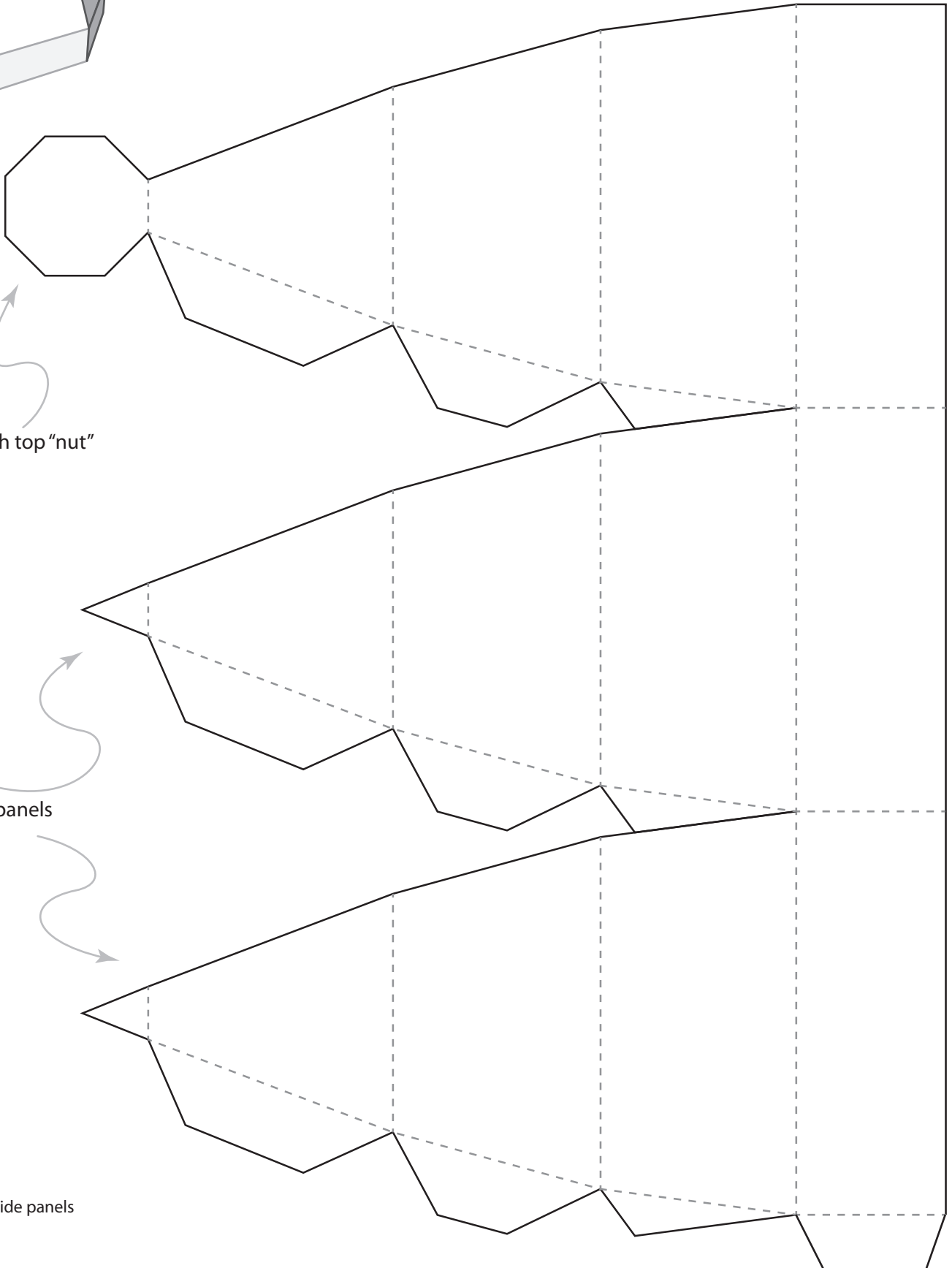


Papercraft Tricorn Hat Template: The Crown (page 1 of 2)

Size: Adult Male (23" circumference head opening)



The finished crown is made up of 8 panels (an octagonal dome):
one top panel with the "nut" plus 7 additional "basic" panels



Only one panel with top "nut"

A total of 7 "basic" panels

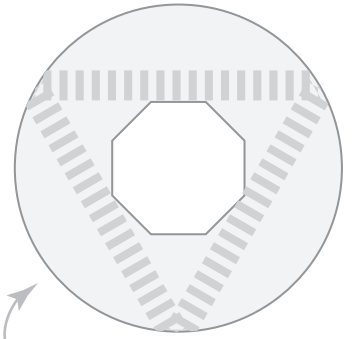
Cut out three of these side panels



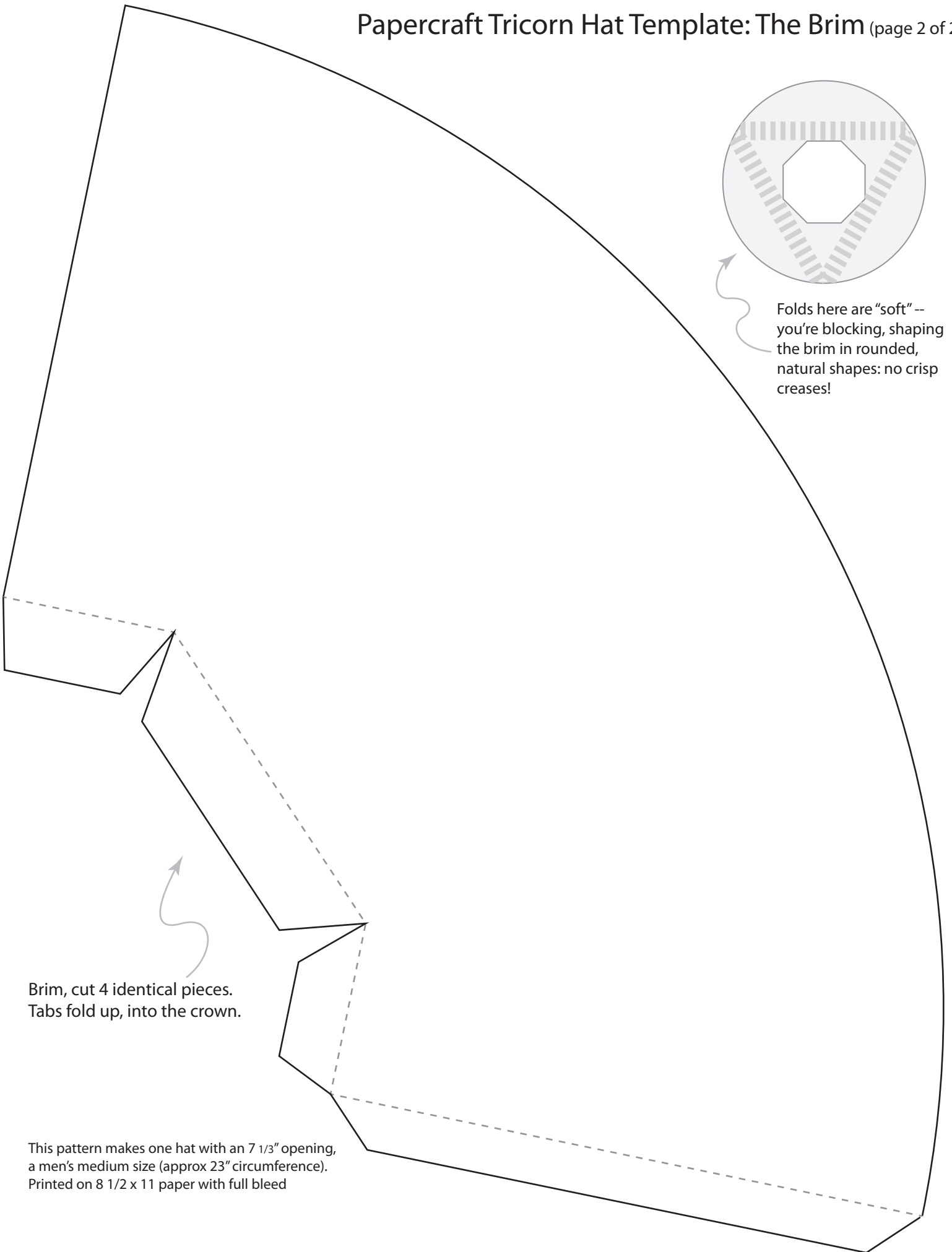

Papercraft Tricorn Hat Template: The Brim (page 2 of 2)



Folds here are "soft" -- you're blocking, shaping the brim in rounded, natural shapes: no crisp creases!



Brim, cut 4 identical pieces.
Tabs fold up, into the crown.

This pattern makes one hat with an $7 \frac{1}{3}$ " opening,
a men's medium size (approx 23" circumference).
Printed on $8 \frac{1}{2}$ x 11 paper with full bleed
